






#### **REGULATIONS**

- The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit and will not, under any circumstances hold Itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or exhibits of any kind or for any damage done-there-to.
- Amplification may be permitted at the discretion of and under the direction of the ground Steward.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be speaking or acting in an abusive or offensive way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be treating an animal in a cruel way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- The Society reserves the right to test horse exhibits for prohibitive substances.
- Where heights are set out, all animals may be measured on the ground before being allowed to compete.
- District competitors must reside within a 30km radius of Batlow which Includes Tumut, Adelong and Tumbarumba.
- Novice competitors have not won a first prize in a similar event at an agricultural show.
- Intermediate horses must not have placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at a Royal Show or won or been runner up at a HOTY show.
- A pony does not exceed 14hh. A Galloway is over 14hh not exceeding 15hh. A hack is over 15hh.
- Unless stated otherwise, a child rider is to be under 17 years of age.
- Events may be split or merged at the discretion of the Judge.
- Height certificates and Registration papers must be carried and shown on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination
- Horses competing in Breed Classes must be current financial members of the relevant Breed Society.
   Membership evidence must be presented on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination
- All prizemoney winners will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Show Treasurer at the Pavilion to redeem your prizemoney only AFTER 2pm. Any monies unclaimed on the day in person will be forfeited.
- All winners of sponsored horsefeed will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Announcers Green shed near the grandstand to collect your prize at any time **before 4pm**. Any horsefeed not collected by 4pm will be forfeited.
- Some prize awards may be made in the Rings at the time of being judged.

#### To help you plan your entries:

Competitors who have won a Champion award in the First Chance Ring Classes are not eligible to compete in the Second Chance Ring Classes

Open Hack or Open Show Hunter? You may only compete as either a Hack or a Show Hunter on the day

Brumby Exhibitor? We are offering a range of showing classes for both Registered and Unregistered Led and Ridden Brumbies. Your Ring will have its own Supreme Led Brumby award. This award has been very well sponsored. Brumbies cannot compete in any classes in Rings 1, 2 and 3 or be eligible for Major awards from those Rings (see options below) with ONE exception: Any Brumby rider under 18 IS PERMITTED to compete for the HV SMITH Memorial Encouragement Award

A Brumby exhibitor may nominate to compete in Rings 1, 2 or 3 on the day as a Pony, Show Hunter or Hack but this will make you ineligible to compete in any Brumby Classes in Ring 4.

Heavy Horse exhibitor? Your Ring will have its own Supreme Led Heavy Horse awards. This award is very well sponsored. Heavy Horses are not eligible to compete in any classes in Rings 1, 2 and 3 or be eligible for Major awards from those Rings with ONE exception: <u>Any Heavy Horse rider under 18 IS PERMITTED</u> to compete for the HV Smith Memorial Encouragement Award.

#### INDEMNITY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY All COMPETITORS

Horse Ring Office/Registration will take place in Green office next to Grandstand

**PARKING** Horse floats to park in designated horse parking area.

Please consider others; parking is limited, so drive through to the farthest available space to avoid blocking others. If requested to move by any steward, you must comply as quickly as possible.

NB. Any competitor found exercising their horse on the golf course will be disqualified.

Any person riding a horse on/within the show grounds MUST be wearing an ASA certified helmet.

#### **TIMETABLE**

Judging in Rings 1, 2, 3 and 4 commences at 9 am sharp.

Heavy Horse judging in Ring 5 commences at 10 am sharp with Led classes

Heavy Horse Action classes will commence after Major award judging and not before 12 noon

#### **Major Award judging**

All Major Awards will be judged by the 3 judges of the day at the conclusion of judging in Rings 1, 2 and 3.

If judging in Rings 4 and 5 has not finished we will hold these rings up for competitors (under 18) who wish to compete for the HV Smith Memorial Encouragement Award. Announcements will be made. Competitors will be given time to saddle/unsaddle. Judging in this order:

#### 1. HV Smith Memorial Encouragement Award

Who is eligible? All competitors <u>under 18</u> mounted on any horse or pony (including lead rein) that they have competed on during the day, are invited to compete. You do not need to have won or been placed in any class on the day. This award is all about inclusiveness and encouragement. Each judge will evaluate the horse/rider combination by points. Judging criteria are rider kindness, empathy with horse, suitability of horse for purpose and rider ability. Combinations may be asked for a very simple workout relevant to the horse and rider combination.

Prize: Rosette or sash plus \$25 sponsored by Forestry Corporation of NSW

#### 2. Supreme Champion Led Horse of the Show

Who is eligible? All Led Hacks, Galloways, Show Hunter Hacks, and Ponies who have been awarded a Champion Led on the day (Rings 1,2 and 3 only)

Prize: Sash plus a rug sponsored by PW and HA Forsyth

#### 3. Supreme Champion Show Hunter of the Show

Who is eligible? All ridden Show Hunter Hacks, Galloways and Ponies who have been awarded a Champion Ridden on the day (Rings 1, 2 and 3 only and excluding Rider Classes)


